

## TRAIL RIDING

Scenic Trail Rides are offered year-round. One or more trail guides lead each ride. Riding experiences range from gentle pastures, to wide sloping trails, crossing small or medium sized streams, and even some trails that are narrow, windy, wooded and steep. Summer rides are cool (90% in the shade)!

Specific rides are tailored to the skill level of the riders and the condition of the trails. We can accommodate large groups!

**We'll beat any other current local hardcopy trail riding rate (just bring other flier / ad with you).**

**Standard Rates (riding helmets included):**

**\$35 for one hour, per person**

**\$45 for 1.5 hours, \$55 for two hours**

**Exclusive Ride- Just you (and/or yours)!** You get a private trail guide for just you and your party. Great for romantic occasions! Use of gazebo and grill included before or after the ride. **Per Person: \$55 for one hour, \$80 for 1.5 hours or \$105 for two hours**

Please arrive 15 minutes early, and wear attire appropriate for the weather conditions. We reserve the right to cancel a ride for poor weather conditions.


**Pony Rides Available (ages 2 and up): \$20 for ½ hour or \$35 for an hour, per pony.**



## CONTACT INFORMATION

### Directions from Downtown Front Royal:

1. Drive 6 blocks north of Main Street
2. Turn Right (East) onto 6<sup>th</sup> Street
3. After ½ mile, 6<sup>th</sup> becomes Happy Creek Road
4. After 2 more miles, Happy Creek crosses a railroad track and goes under I66. It then becomes Morgan Ford Road.
5. After 1 more mile, you will pass by our outdoor riding arena on the left.
6. Turn Left into the next entrance (509 Morgan Ford Rd.) just before the log house.
7. Office is down the steps and under the log house.

Certified Instructors provide riding lessons in Royal Horseshoe Farm's new riding arena. We teach English, Dressage and Western riding.

Dress Appropriately: long pants, and riding boots or shoes with a small heel. ASTM/SEI helmets provided if rider doesn't bring one.

## HISTORICAL HORSE FARM



Royal Horseshoe Farm has a 270 year history, including the oldest house in Warren County, visits by George Washington (the first in 1748, at age 16 while surveying for Lord Fairfax), ownership by John Marshall (Chief Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court 1801-1835) and action during the Civil War. You can ride past a cannon emplacement that guarded Morgan's Ford on the Shenandoah River.

In the early 1900's, the farm provided horses to the Front Royal Remount Center (U.S. Cavalry). Our historic barns have been carefully renovated, preserving much of the old character and construction.
